

RESOLUTION NO. 19R-02-30

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN GARY MONROE AND THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL; APPROVING PAYMENT BY THE CITY TO RESOLVE THE WORKERS` COMPENSATION CLAIM IN THE TOTAL WASHOUT SETTLEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$437,500.00 INCLUSIVE OF ATTORNEYS FEES AND COSTS AND BENEFITS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, CHARLES FARANDA).

WHEREAS, Gary Monroe has made a worker`s compensation claim against the City of Lauderhill; and

WHEREAS, the merits of the claim have been investigated by the City; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Lauderhill that the matter be resolved;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Lauderhill hereby approves the proposed workers compensation settlement to be made to Gary Monroe in the total washout settlement amount of \$437,500.00, inclusive of all benefits, attorneys fees and costs, as full and final settlement in exchange for a general release.

SECTION 2. The City Manager and all other appropriate officials are authorized to execute settlement documents and all other documents necessary to fulfill the terms of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
