ORDINANCE NO. 170-02-109

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 11½, HOUSING, ARTICLE IV, ASSISTANCE, SECTION 11½-65, AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE, TO ALLOW ITS MEMBERS TO SERVE ON OTHER CITY BOARDS OR COMMITTEES SIMULTANEOUSLY WITH SERVICE ON THIS COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY COMMISSION)

WHEREAS, when the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee was established it was silent as to whether its members could serve on other City Boards or Committees while simultaneously serving on this Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission would like to propose an amendment whereby the Affordable Housing Committee can simultaneously serve on other City Boards or Committees which also allow dual office serving;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 11½, Housing, Article IV, Assistance, Section 11½-65, Affordable Housing Advisory Committee, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. $11\frac{1}{2}$ -65. - Affordable housing advisory committee.

Pursuant to the requirements of the act, there is hereby created and established an affordable housing advisory committee ("committee"). Composition of the committee shall be as required by the act. Members of the committee shall be appointed by resolution pursuant to the requirements of the article within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this article.

Members of this Committee are permitted to simultaneously serve on other City Boards or Committees.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances, all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions, in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed as to the extent of such conflict.
