

RESOLUTION NO. 19R-06-104

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING SOLAR EFFORTS AND PROGRAMS INCLUDING SOLAR CO-OPS, SOLARTOGETHER, SOLARNOW, AND OTHER PROGRAMS WHICH SUPPORT AND PROMOTE COST EFFECTIVE SOLAR ENERGY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY MAYOR KEN THURSTON)

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill supports sustainable and green living; and

WHEREAS, solar energy allows citizens to move energy consumption to a more environmentally-friendly source, providing a self-sustaining, pollution-free form of energy; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interests of the residents of the City of Lauderhill to support and benefit from renewable resources such as solar power;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All backup attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. That the City of Lauderhill supports solar efforts and the formation of solar co-ops that will benefit residents by providing bulk purchasing of solar panels.

Section 3. That the City of Lauderhill supports established utility solar programs such as SolarTogether, SolarNow, and any future solar programs which allow the City, residential and business customers the opportunity to share in the benefits and economies of solar as a cost effective, hassle-free solar alternative for Lauderhill residents.

Section 4. That if any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this Resolution.

Section 5. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
