**RESOLUTION NO. 17R-02-57: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE PIGGYBACK OF THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT (FDLE) CONTRACT (#ITN 1531) FOR THE PURCHASE OF LIVSCAN EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE FROM BIOMETRIC4ALL IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$15,000.00; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT FROM THE APPROPRIATE BUDGET CODE NUMBER; PROVIDING TERMS AND CONDITIONS (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, CHARLES FARANDA)**

**Request Action:** THE LAUDERHILL POLICE DEPARTMENT REQUESTS APPROVAL FROM THE CITY COMMISSION TO PIGGYBACK FROM THE FDLE CONTRACT #ITN 1531 FOR THE PURCHASE OF LIVSCAN EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE FROM BIOMETRICS4ALL.

**Need:**

THE CONTRACT WILL ENABLE THE CITY TO PURCHASE LIVSCAN EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE WHICH WILL BE USED FOR PRE-EMPLOYMENT FINGERPRINT PROCESSING OF APPLICANTS.

**Summary Explanation/ Background:**

THE FDLE AWARDED THEIR LIVSCAN EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE TO BIOMETRICS4ALL. THE FDLE CONTRACT IS VALID FROM DECEMBER 2015 - DECEMBER 2018, THE CONTRACT ALLOWS FOR THE PRACTICE OF "PIGGYBACKING", WHEREIN CITIES MAY UTILIZE THE SAME PRICING, TERMS AND CONDITIONS.
