Request Action:

Appoint two members to the Advisory Council of the Isles of Inverrary Safe Neighborhood Improvement District for a two year term.

Summary Explanation/ Background:

All members shall be subject to the rules and procedures for boards and committees set out in the city code, chapter 2, article I.
