

RESOLUTION NO. 24R-02-34

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER (SRO) AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA AND THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL TO PROVIDE MODIFICATION TO TERMS INCLUDING AN INCREASE IN PAYMENT TO THE CITY FOR SRO PROGRAM SERVICES FOR TWO (2) SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS WITH ANNUAL INCREASES; PROVIDING FOR ONE SRO AT PARKWAY MIDDLE SCHOOL AND ONE SRO AT LAUDERHILL 6-12 HIGH SCHOOL; PROVIDING FOR A THREE (3) YEAR TERM FROM AUGUST 14, 2023 THROUGH JUNE 2026; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, DESORAE GILES-SMITH)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The First Amendment to the School Resource Officer Agreement between the School Board of Broward County, Florida and the City of Lauderhill, Florida regarding the assignments of a total of two (2) School Resource Officers (SROs) to assist in the SRO Program to provide safe-school officers at the two (2) designated schools within the City of Lauderhill including Lauderhill 6-12 and Parkway Middle School, providing for a three (3) year term commencing August 14, 2023 and ending June 2026, amending the terms to include an increase in payment with annual increases, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. Providing for funding in the amount of \$108,150.00 per officer for the 2023-2024 School Year; \$113,557.50 per officer for the 2024-2025 School Year; and \$119,235.40*per officer for the 2025-2026 School Year. (*the last year is contingent upon the certified taxable value not dropping below 5%.)

SECTION 3. The City Manager and all appropriate city officials are authorized to execute these contracts and any other documents required to fulfill the terms of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
