

RESOLUTION NO. 19R-01-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL APPOINTING VARIOUS MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL PUBLIC ART COMMITTEE BY VARIOUS INDIVIDUAL CITY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE TERMS INDICATED; APPOINTING TWO (2) MEMBERS BY THE CITY COMMISSION AS A WHOLE TO SERVE AS ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TWO YEAR TERM EXPIRING NOVEMBER 2020; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, CHARLES FARANDA)

WHEREAS, the Public Art Committee members were previously all appointed by the Commission as a Whole for 2-year staggered terms; and

WHEREAS, via Resolution No. 17R-02-47, the City Commission changed the appointments of the 5 members to be made by the individual city commissioners concurrent with their seat term and for the alternates to be appointed by the city commission as a whole for a two-year term with staggered terms;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The appointments of the following Members of the Public Art Committee shall be made by each individual commissioner indicated for the expiration of term to be concurrent with the city commissioner`s term, as follows:

- a. Mayor Ken Thurston hereby appoints Wayne L. Alexander to serve as a Member through November 2022.
- b. Commissioner Denise D. Grant hereby appoints Charlene Bouie to serve as a Member through November 2022.
- c. Commissioner Richard Campbell hereby appoints Julian Chamberlain to serve as a Member through November 2020.
- d. Janet J. Rooks and Gail E. Bouie are hereby appointed by the City Commission as a Whole to serve as Alternate Members of the Committee for the remainder of the term expiring November 2020.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
