A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL APPROVING THE TENTATIVE PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR THE ISLES OF INVERRARY SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AT THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE OF TWO (2) MILLS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026 COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2025 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2026 ADOPTING THE PROPOSED NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) PER PARCEL OF LAND PER YEAR FOR THE ISLES OF INVERRARY SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2025 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2026; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes, Section 163.5151, requires the local governing body of the City where the Safe Neighborhood Improvement District is located to approve the proposed tax levy at a proposed millage rate prior to the final adoption by the Safe Neighborhood Improvement District Board of Directors which will be held on September 29, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Advisory Council met and approved this millage rate and non-ad valorem assessment amount for Fiscal Year 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>. The proposed tax levy at the proposed millage rate of Two (2.0) mills for the Isles of Inverrary Safe Neighborhood Improvement District for Fiscal Year 2025 commencing October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2026 as approved by the Board of Directors, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

<u>Section 2</u>. The non-ad valorem special assessment in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$500.00) per parcel of land per year for Fiscal Year 2026 commencing October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2026, as approved by the Board of Directors, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

<u>Section 3</u>. It is noted that the proposed ad valorem tax levy and non-ad valorem special assessment are both incorporated as a part of the City of Lauderhill General Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2026.

<u>Section 4</u>. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
