ORDINANCE NO. 21O-06-120: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA AMENDING THE LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS (LDR) TO

AMEND ARTICLE III, ZONING DISTRICTS, SECTION 5.32.2, RESTAURANT, FAST FOOD WITH OR WITHOUT DRIVE-THROUGH AND HIGH TURNOVER WITH DRIVE-THROUGH; PROVIDING FOR LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS FOR EXISTING RESTAURANT, FAST FOOD WITH OR WITHOUT DRIVE-THROUGH AND HIGH TURNOVER WITH DRIVE-THROUGH BUILDINGS; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, DESORAE GILES-SMITH).

Need: The objective of this ordinance amendment is to provide an exception to the distance separation requirements established in Article III, Section 5.32.2.E for Existing Buildings originally improved for a Restaurant, fast food with or drive-through and high turnover with drive-through use. The proposed Ordinance will ultimately still require a Special Exception for buildings originally improved for a Restaurant, fast food with or drive-through and high turnover with drive-through uses.
