

RESOLUTION NO. 19R-09-186

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL AT THE PROPOSED OPERATING MILLAGE RATE OF 8.9898 PER ONE THOUSAND DOLLAR (\$1,000) ASSESSMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2019 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2020; ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE VOTED DEBT SERVICE MILLAGE AT A RATE OF 1.8500 PER ONE THOUSAND DOLLAR (\$1,000) ASSESSMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2019 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2020; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, last year's millage rate was 7.9898 and the voted debt service millage was at a rate of 1.9464 per One Thousand Dollar (\$1,000) assessment; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has reviewed the tentative proposed operating millage rate and tentative proposed voted debt service millage rate for the City of Lauderhill for Fiscal Year 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission considers the tentative operating millage rate and tentative voted debt service millage rate to be proper and necessary for the City of Lauderhill Property Tax Levy for the year commencing October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The tentative Property Tax Levy for the City of Lauderhill for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020 at the operating millage rate of 8.9898 per One Thousand Dollar (\$1,000) assessment, which is greater than the rate that was in effect last year and which reflects a 12.52% change from the rate that was in effect last year, is hereby approved.

Section 2. The 2019-2020 tentative *aggregate* operating millage rate of 9.0157 per One Thousand Dollar (\$1,000) assessment is an increase over the *aggregate* rolled back rate of 7.6742 by 17.48%. That the City of Lauderhill General Fund tentative operating millage rate of 8.9898 is an increase over the rolled-back rate of 7.6458 by 17.48%.

Section 3. The tentative voted debt service millage rate of 1.8500 per One Thousand Dollar (\$1,000) assessment is hereby approved.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
