

RESOLUTION NO. 25R-10-204

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL FOR STAFF SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH HEARINGS BEFORE THE BROWARD COUNTY UNSAFE STRUCTURES BOARD; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 20R-02-56, adopted on February 24, 2020, Broward County and the City of Lauderhill entered into an Interlocal Agreement for staff services in connection with hearings before the Broward County Unsafe Structures Board, and such agreement expired on September 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into a new agreement for the same services for a term expiring September 30, 2030.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the Interlocal Agreement Between Broward County and City of Lauderhill staff services in connection with hearings before the Broward County Unsafe Structures Board is hereby approved, and the Mayor and City Manager are authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
