

RESOLUTION NO. 20R-10-221

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL FOR COMMUNITY BUS SHUTTLE SERVICES TO AMEND THE RATE OF FUNDING TO BE REIMBURSED TO THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, DESORAE GILES-SMITH)

WHEREAS, Broward County previously advised that it will fund all community bus shuttle service routes utilizing 100% of funding from Transportation Sales Tax Funds; and

WHEREAS, we previously approved Resolution No. 19R-09-200 approving the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County which includes all the terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, the third party contractor, South Florida Limousines, advised of the modified rate of \$45.00 per hours; and

WHEREAS, this First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement reflects the actual modified rate to be charged by the operator as the rate for reimbursement to the City of Lauderhill;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Lauderhill and Broward County to modify the hourly rate for reimbursement to be equal to the actual rate charged by the third party operator, South Florida Limousines, as reflected in the modified Exhibit "F", for community bus services, a copy of the First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement and the amended Exhibit F which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference, are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The City Manager and all appropriate city officials are authorized to execute this Agreement and any other documents required to fulfill the terms of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
