

RESOLUTION NO. 25R-09-189

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BROWARD COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR TO COLLECT NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTION TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, for fiscal year 2026 the City of Lauderhill intends to levy non-ad valorem assessments under Florida law within the incorporated area of the City and only to designated parcels; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Lauderhill believes it is in the best interest of the City of Lauderhill to enter into an agreement with the Broward County Tax Collector which will allow each parcel to be billed and collected for the non-ad valorem assessments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Commission of the City of Lauderhill hereby authorizes the City Manager or designee with the authority to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the Broward County Tax Collector to collect non-ad valorem assessments as part of the same bill as ad valorem taxes.

SECTION 2. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
