

RESOLUTION NO. 25R-03-55

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR A PERMIT TO INSTALL PUBLIC ART ON TRAFFIC CONTROL BOXES ALONG STATE ROAD 7 AND IF APPROVED, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE COMMUNITY AESTHETIC FEATURE AGREEMENT TO PROCEED WITH THE INSTALLATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY INTERIM CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, in the past few years, the City of Lauderhill has applied for and has received approval from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to install public art at various locations within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to install student artwork on traffic control boxes along State Road 7, in the City of Lauderhill; and

WHEREAS, FDOT requires the City to request permission for the installation of the student artwork on traffic control boxes along State Road 7 in the City of Lauderhill, and if permission is granted, to enter into a Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement (CAFA) in order to proceed with said installation; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it is in the best interests of the City to authorize the Interim City Manager or designee to submit the above referenced request for permission to FDOT, and if permission is granted, to execute the CAFA, and to do all things necessary to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The above recitations are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Interim City Manager or designee is authorized to request permission from FDOT to install student artwork on traffic control boxes along State Road 7 in the City of Lauderhill, and if permission is granted, to execute the Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement (CAFA) attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, and to do all things necessary to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
