

RESOLUTION NO. 26R-01-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A FACILITY LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH CYTT, INC., FOR COMMUNITY PROGRAMMING AT THE WINDERMERE COMMUNITY CENTER, SAID AGREEMENT IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE SAME FORM AS EXHIBIT "A"; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE TWO YEAR AGREEMENT; PROVIDING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY WITH THE AUTHORITY TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, the City owns and operates public facilities for municipal, community, recreational, educational, and cultural purposes; and

WHEREAS, CYTT, Inc., seeks limited access to designated areas within a City facility for the provision of arts-based, educational, enrichment, and community programming that serves a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City is willing to grant a revocable, non-exclusive license for such use, at the Windermere Community Center, subject at all times to City operational needs, public access requirements, and City scheduling priority; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to enter into a non-exclusive Facility License Agreement with CYTT, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the above recitations are true and correct.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is authorized to execute the Facility License Agreement, in substantially the same form as **Exhibit "A"**, which shall be in effect for a two year term with the option to renew for an additional year upon City Commission approval.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
