Question 1: What is the engineers cost estimate for the project?

Answer 1: The engineers cost estimate for NW 33rd AVE & NW 14th ST Roundabout and NW 34th AVE and NW 9th ST Roundabout is in the order of \$300,000.00.

Question 2: Exhibit A Price Bid Sheet appears to only include quantities for the construction of one roundabout (NW 33rd Ave and NW 14th St). Please verify if the other roundabout is not included (NW 34th Ave and NW 9th St).

Answer 2: Please see attached Bid Sheet for the roundabout NW 34th AVE & NW 9th ST.

Question 3: Please provide measurement and payment definition information for the project or indicate where this information is.

Answer 3: Unless otherwise noted in the technical specifications: installation, acceptance, and payment for all items required in these plans shall be in accordance with the current editions of the following, referenced in the key sheet: Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), FDOT Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction (Standard Specifications), FDOT Roadway and Traffic Design Standards (Standard Indexes), Broward County Minimum Standards, Broward County Traffic Engineering Division Standards and Specifications, and any or all Broward County Traffic Engineering Requirements that meet or exceed those found in the above referenced documents.

Question 4: Bid item #4 "Relocate Mailbox" indicates 0 however the plans show 2 relocation's (on NW 34th Ave and NW 9th St). Please verify if this quantity is to change.

Answer 4: Please see attached Bid Sheet for the roundabout NW 34th AVE & NW 9th ST.

Question 5: Bid item #19 "Detectable Warning" indicates 80 LF. Please provide the width or provide quantity in SF instead.

Answer 5: The Bid item #19 "Detectable Warning" should have been 80 SF. Please see attached Bid Sheets for the roundabout NW 34th AVE & NW 9th ST and NW 33rd AVE & NW 14th ST.

Question 6: Bid items #22 and #23 indicate 4 trees and 1 tree respectively, however these quantities are for one roundabout only. Please verify if this quantity is to change.

Answer 6: Please see attached Bid Sheet for the roundabout NW 34th AVE & NW 9th ST.

Question 7: Bid items #29-34 all indicate paint pavement marking in addition to bid item #45 "painted pavement markings, final surface" please indicate the intent of bid item #45 or what is to be included in this price.

Answer 7: Bid item #45 "painted pavement markings, final surface" has been removed from the Bid Sheet. Bid Sheets for both roundabouts has been revised and are attached.

Question 8: Bid item #46 "Contingency Allowance" is usually provided by the City. Is this item for both locations and how much should it be?

Answer 8: The Bid item #46 "Contingency Allowance" should have been \$20,000.00 for each location. Please see attached Bid Sheets for the roundabout NW 34th AVE & NW 9th ST and NW 33rd AVE & NW 14th ST.

Question 9: Plan page 9 shows one speed hump and plan page 10 shows four speed humps, are these new speed humps or existing with new markings needed? If they are new speed humps can you please provide the details?

Answer 9: That is correct. Plan page 9 shows one speed hump and plan page 10 shows four speed humps. These are proposed (new) speed humps. A speed hump detail and specification was included with the bid. See the last page of the Broward County Traffic detail sheets (Speed Humps Specification sheet 1 of 1).

Question 10: Is the crosswalk area to be milled and resurfaced prior to laying stamped asphalt? If so, please verify if this quantity is to be added to milling and resurfacing item.

Answer 10: Yes, quantity is to be added to milling and resurfacing item.




