Request Action:

Requesting the City Commission to approve the Fourth Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement between Broward County and the City of Lauderhill to provide for Community Shuttle Service for Lauderhill residents through September 30, 2025.

Need Summary Explanation/ Background:

The City of Lauderhill and Broward County entered into an Interlocal Agreement dated September 30, 2019 which provides for Community Shuttle Service as an alternative form of public transportation for residents within the jurisdictional limits of the City. The Parties desire to enter this Amendment to extend the term of the Agreement.
