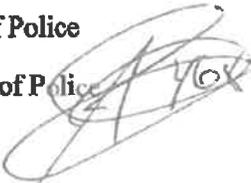

Subject: Request for Law Enforcement Trust Funds

The police department is requesting to utilize Federal Law Enforcement Forfeiture Funds to purchase the following items:

Twenty-seven Laptop computers: These will replace older lap tops utilized by road patrol officers, in the field. The replacement of these computers are required due to recent enhancements in Law Enforcement Technology. These enhancements include new license plate readers, an updated reporting system, body worn camera implementation, and other technological improvements that older computers are not capable of processing. It is requested that \$40,000 of LEFF funds are allotted for this purchase.

FARO Crime Scene Mapping technology: Over the past two years, the current mapping software and equipment has become outdated and obsolete. Technology has increased to the point that our current system is no longer supported and does not provide the graphics needed for courtroom presentation in today's environment. During the past year and a half, we have needed to borrow equipment from a surrounding agency in order to properly document large traffic homicide scenes. Additionally, newer technology provides a more detailed 3D drawing. It is requested that \$115,000 LEFF funds are allotted for this purchase.

Module furniture for the Criminal Investigations Division: When the police department was built, it was not outfitted with the consideration for growth. The department has run short staffed, however, in recent years the gaps in staffing have decreased. As a result, the agency can backfill investigative positions that have not been staffed for quite some time. The issue, is that there is no place for these detective to work. In order to provide a proper work space, the unit requires a reconfiguration of the module furniture. This would provide for fifteen workstations, an increase of five from the current ten. We contacted several vendors, utilized by the city, to learn that the current furniture cannot be reconfigured. Therefore, the new design requires all new furniture. It is requested that \$120,000 in LEFF funds are allotted for this purchase.

Stop the Bleed, Field Trauma Kits: The police department is in need of necessary lifesaving equipment, that officers and Police Service Aids can utilize in the field. Based on recent events,

this equipment is becoming standard issue for Law Enforcement Agencies across the nation. As this is new program for the agency, I am requesting \$16,000 of Federal Forfeiture Funds to outfit all uniform personnel.

I am requesting your consideration for \$291,000 from the Federal Law Enforcement Forfeiture Fund to make these purchases. Upon submission of our 2018 fiscal report to the Department of Justice there was a balance of \$321,936.80 in our Federal Forfeiture Account. No funds have been expended since that date.

Subject: Proposal for purchase of Trauma Kits

Chief Stanley,

This memorandum is authored to serve as a request for the purchase of trauma kits for the police department. These trauma kits are critical for providing our officers the tools to survive injuries involving massive blood loss. The purpose for trauma kits is to stop bleeding before it becomes fatal. The items that I will mention are all proven to stop arterial bleeding, which can result in death within one to three minutes of an injury occurring, if left untreated. Furthermore, research has shown that even one minute of unchecked arterial bleeding is enough to cause permanent brain damage or death. Additionally, this type of bleeding cannot be stopped by conventional means (pressure, elevation, standard bandages, etc.).

At this time, only Lauderhill Fire Rescue (LFR) possesses the tools to stop arterial bleeding if one of our officers becomes injured in this manner. Current protocol dictates that LFR will not enter an active scene and treat our officers until the situation is deemed safe. I believe that the elapsed time before treatment begins will be too great in a situation where one or more of our officers are suffering from a severed artery. Even if LFR was to disregard this protocol and enter an active scene, their response time alone would exceed the one minute window needed to start treatment on this type of injury.

A fatal situation like this can be prevented by providing our officers with a trauma kit that possesses at least the following items: CAT tourniquet, QuikClot, pressure dressing, and surgical shears. The CAT tourniquet will be used for injuries to extremities where arterial bleeding is present. QuikClot will be used for parts of the body where a tourniquet can't be applied (neck, torso), and as a supplementary means in the event that a tourniquet alone is not enough to stop arterial bleeding. The pressure dressing will be used for injuries where a tourniquet or QuikClot is not practical or advisable (head injuries). The surgical shears are necessary in order to expose the wound site and therefore ensure proper application of the tourniquet or QuikClot.

Each of these items serve a specific purpose and the trauma kits shouldn't be downsized in order to ensure overall effectiveness and field application . These trauma kits will save lives and it is very important that we obtain them as soon as possible to ensure our officers have the means to stay alive before LFR comes to their aid.

I conducted extensive research regarding vendors who are able to outfit our department with the appropriate trauma kits, and the three with the lowest costs are:

1. North American Rescue: \$71.90 each, 130 kits = \$9,355.40.
2. Tactical Medical Solutions, Inc.: \$71.94 each, 130 kits = \$9,427.09.
3. Safeware: \$81.90 each, 130 kits = \$10,647.

The only item in these kits that expires and will need to be replaced regardless of use is QuikClot. This item has a serviceable use life of 5 years, after which the impregnated clotting agent in the gauze begins to decay. North American Rescue offered the best price per unit at \$33.98. The total cost to replace the *QuikClot* every five years will be \$4467.40.

The only other item that would have to be replaced, if used, is the pressure dressing. North American Rescue offered the best price per unit at \$5.49 each. The CAT tourniquet and trauma shears are practically unbreakable and can be sanitized after use. However, if needed to be replaced, North American Rescue offered the best price per Tourniquet at \$22.11 each and the trauma shears at \$6.60 each.

These items are sent loose, and in order to allow officers to carry the trauma kits on their person, Individual First Aid Kit pouches (IFAK) will need to be purchased. These pouches, are compact in size and will allow officers to carry the trauma kits on their vest or gun belt. Having the pouches would also ensure officers don't lose individual items in their trauma kits. Tactical Medical Solutions has the best price for this pouch at \$19.57 each (\$2572.82 for 130 pouches).

The department is in need of 130 trauma kits. Once obtained, a trauma kit will be issued to every employee that is currently, or could potentially be involved in First Responder duties. This will include all sworn law enforcement and PSA members of the Agency. After outfitting all sworn members of the agency, approximately 15 additional trauma kits will be available to outfit future hires and those currently at the Police Academy.

Research has shown that heavy blood loss often leads to the loss of motor skills and the onset of hypovolemic shock. Having a specific tourniquet carrier would allow officers easy access to their tourniquet before shock and the loss of motor skills compromises their ability to apply the tourniquet. These items are needed in order to make the tourniquet easily accessible to first responders without having to reach inside their issued pouch to get it, which requires motor skills to access. Although there are a variety of tourniquet carriers, the rigid plastic cases are best due

to their durability, open set up, and ease of access. By contrast, a soft fabric case is usually closed via a Velcro strap which can attach to the Velcro on the tourniquet and create problems during deployment. The other option would be a soft fabric button down case which is not as easily accessible as the open set up of the rigid carrier and can complicate deployment in the event of shock or loss of fine motor skills. The same companies offer the rigid case:

1. North American Rescue: \$28.98 each, 130 = \$3767.40.
2. Tactical Medical Solutions, Inc.: \$31.58 each, 130 = \$4105.40.
3. Safeware: \$53.75 each, 130 = \$6987.50.

Summary:

I am requesting the use of \$15,695.62 (based on the best price) to purchase the listed items in the trauma kits, the OIFAKP-B pouches, and the Rigid Tourniquet Case.

Should the need for replacement arise in the future this would be the breakdown by each item:

1. QuikClot - Combat Gauze: \$33.98 each
2. CAT Tourniquet: \$22.11 each
3. Pressure Dressing: \$5.49 each
4. Trauma Shears: \$6.60 each
5. IFAK Pouch: \$19.57 each
6. Rigid Tourniquet Case: \$28.98 each

I am currently in the process of applying for a grant that will help to pay for some of the costs associated with this request. The American Police and Sheriffs Association offers an equipment grant could fund up to \$5,000 of the cost.

What is arterial bleeding?

Arterial blood is bright red and spurts out of a wound in time with the patient's pulse.

In contrast, venous blood is darker and while it does not spurt, blood loss can be heavy.



Facts about arterial bleeding

Depending on which artery is severed, if not stopped, death will always result between 30 seconds and three minutes.

Arterial bleeding cannot be stopped with direct pressure and elevation.

Hemorrhage is responsible for 91.5 percent of potentially survivable battlefield deaths.

There are more than 20 major arteries throughout the body and three critical ones (Carotid, Brachial, and Femoral).

Tourniquet: The successful use of tourniquets by the military over the past decade has saved countless lives. Two large military studies conducted in Iraq show a 90% and 96% survival rate when tourniquets were applied before the onset of volume shock, and 0% survival rate when not applied but needed.

QuikClot: Reacts with blood to form a localized clot independent of normal clotting. Hemostatic dressings are used in conjunction with pressure bandages when a tourniquet is unavailable or inappropriate.

Pressure dressing: Follows the same concept of QuikClot minus the active agent (Kaolin) in the bandage. Kaolin is an inorganic mineral that accelerates the body's natural clotting ability without burning the skin as previous clotting agents before it.

Boston police officers purchased 1,500 tourniquets and training within a month after the bombings in 2013.

In Dallas, where police officers have been issued tourniquets, Lt. Alex Eastman said it's about time. "I've been pushing for this for years," he told *New Jersey's Courier Post*.

More than 200 Quick Clot Trauma Belts were provided for line officers of the Rapides Parish Sheriff's Office and police departments in Alexandria and Pineville following the death of three Baton Rouge area police officers this summer. ***The kits were donated by Rapides Regional Medical Center, not purchased.
