

RESOLUTION NO. 25R-12-146

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, REQUESTING AN EXTENSION OF THE DEADLINES SET FORTH IN SECTION 197.3632, FLORIDA STATUTES, FOR THE ADOPTION AND TRANSMITTAL OF THE CITY'S INTENT RESOLUTION TO USE THE UNIFORM METHOD OF COLLECTING NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS FOR THE BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (BID); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TRANSMIT THE REQUEST TO THE BROWARD COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER AND TAX COLLECTOR; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, KENNIE HOBBS).

WHEREAS, section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, establishes deadlines for a local government adopting, for the first time, an intent resolution to use the uniform method of collecting non-ad valorem assessments; and

WHEREAS, the statute allows the January 1 and January 10 deadlines to be extended to March 1 and March 10, respectively, upon agreement of the Property Appraiser, Tax Collector, and the local government; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill requires additional time to complete the statutory notice process and prepare the required materials for the intent resolution for the Business Improvement District (BID); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds it in the best interest of the City to formally request such an extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City Commission hereby requests that the Broward County Property Appraiser and Broward County Tax Collector agree to extend the statutory deadlines in section 197.3632 to March 1, 2026, for adoption of the intent resolution and March 10, 2026, for transmittal of the adopted resolution.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to transmit this request to the Property Appraiser and Tax Collector by email and/or U.S. mail.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
