

RESOLUTION NO. 19R-06-115

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL FROM SOUTHERN UNDERGROUND UTILITIES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$82,309.00 FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, LABOR, EQUIPMENT, MATERIAL AND INCIDENTALS TO REPLACE DEFECTIVE VALVES AND ADD NEW VALVES TO THE CITY'S WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM ALONG N.W. 82ND AVENUE AND N.W. 50TH STREET; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT FROM BUDGET CODE NUMBER 401-917-6372; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, CHARLES FARANDA)

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill issued RFQ 2018-052 for repairs to the city's utility system on an "as needed basis"; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor submitted a proposal to the City of Lauderhill; and

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2018 the Lauderhill City Commission approved Resolution No. 18R-12-279 and accepted the Contractor's proposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The Lauderhill City Commission hereby accepts the proposal of Southern Underground Industries to provide construction services, labor, equipment, material and incidentals to replace defective valves and add new valves to the City's water distribution system along N.W. 82nd Avenue and N.W. 50th Street.

SECTION 2. Payment shall be made in a total amount not to exceed \$82,309.00 from Budget Code Number 401-917-6372.

SECTION 3. The City Manager and all appropriate city officials are authorized to negotiation and execute the terms and conditions of the contracts and any other documents required to fulfill the terms of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
