BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant Agreement between the State of Florida Office of the Attorney General and the City of Lauderhill, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City of Lauderhill accepts grant funding in an amount up to \$159,412.00 for reimbursements related to costs for victim services programs under the VOCA Grant, with no matching requirement, which has been waived.

<u>Section 3.</u> The City Manager and City Attorney are given authority to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.
