

RESOLUTION NO. 25R-11-211

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT (VOCA) GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AND THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL; PROVIDING FOR THE CITY TO RECEIVE GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF UP TO \$159,412.00; PROVIDING THAT THERE IS NO MATCHING REQUIREMENT AS IT HAS BEEN WAIVED; PROVIDING FOR TERMS AND CONDITIONS; PROVIDING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY WITH THE AUTHORITY TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA,
THAT:

Section 1. The Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant Agreement between the State of Florida Office of the Attorney General and the City of Lauderhill, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. The City of Lauderhill accepts grant funding in an amount up to \$159,412.00 for reimbursements related to costs for victim services programs under the VOCA Grant, with no matching requirement, which has been waived.

Section 3. The City Manager and City Attorney are given authority to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
