

RESOLUTION NO. 21R-08-181

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL FLORIDA SUPPORTING THE PASSAGE OF THE AMERICAN INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN; REQUESTING THAT ALL FLORIDA U.S. SENATORS AND ALL FLORIDA U.S. HOUSE MEMBERS VOTE IN FAVOR TO PASS THE BILL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY COMMISSIONER MELISSA P. DUNN)

WHEREAS, the Bipartisan Infrastructure Deal will grow the economy, enhance our competitiveness, create good jobs, and make our economy more sustainable, resilient, and just; and

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Deal will create approximately 2 million good-paying union jobs per year over the decade, while accelerating America`s path to full employment and increasing labor force participation; and

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Deal will invest federal dollars in public transit, passenger rail, bridge investment, clean drinking water and waste water infrastructure, access to high-speed internet, and may help tackle the climate crisis by making investments in clean energy and EV infrastructure;

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill wishes to express its support of the American Infrastructure Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified as true and correct and adopted as a part of this Resolution with the exhibits incorporated herein.

Section 2. That the City of Lauderhill supports the passage of the America Infrastructure Plan and strongly encourages Senator Rick Scott, Senator Marco Rubio, Congresswoman Debbie Wasserman Schultz, and Congressman Ted Deutch to vote in favor of the bill to invest needed capital for improvements to America`s infrastructure.

Section 3. That it hereby directs the City Clerk to transmit an executed copy of this Resolution to the Broward League of Cities, the Florida League of Cities, the United States Congressional Delegation from Florida, Senator Rick Scott, Senator Marco Rubio, Congresswoman Debbie Wasserman Schultz, Congressman Ted Deutch, and any other interested parties.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
