

RESOLUTION 19R-04-80

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL RESCINDING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION NO. 19R-03-45; APPROVING THE RANKING OF THE EVALUATION COMMITTEE FOR RFP #2019-006 PUBLIC ART CONSULTANT AS RECOMMENDED BY THE EVALUATION COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT FROM BUDGET CODE NUMBER 001-111-4926 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,200.00 PER MONTH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, CHARLES FARANDA)

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 19R-03-45 was previously passed by the City Commission approving the ranking for RFP #2019—06 Public Art Consultant; and

WHEREAS, that original resolution misstated the dollar amount of the contract; the correct amount is \$3,200.00 per month; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution rescinds and replaces the original resolution dated March 25, 2019 to correct the error regarding the misstated not to exceed amount;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Resolution No. 19R-03-45 is hereby rescinded and replaced with this Resolution.

SECTION 2. The following are ranked to be negotiated with to provide Public Art Consultant services pursuant to RFP #2019-006 in the amount of \$3,200.00 per month as recommended by the Evaluation Committee:

1. THE CULTURAL PLANNING GROUP
2. GADSON & RAVITZ, LLC.
3. DESIGNING LOCAL

SECTION 2. The City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager, or any designee thereof, to negotiate an agreement with the first ranked selected firm to provide Public Art Consultant services pursuant to RFP #2019-006. If an agreement cannot be reached with the first selected firm, then the City Manager, or his designee, shall attempt to negotiate an agreement with the next highest ranked firm, or go out to re-bid if no other firms are ranked, until all services are under contract.

SECTION 3. Payment in the amount of \$3,200.00 per month shall be made from Budget Code Number 001-111-4926.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall have a retroactive effective date of March 25, 2019 which was the date of the passage of the original underlying Resolution.
