

RESOLUTION NO. 20R-07-133

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL RENAMING A PORTION OF N.W. 70th AVENUE WITH THE PRIMARY STREET NAME OF "REV. HERRON AVENUE" FROM COMMERCIAL BOULEVARD TO INVERRARY BOULEVARD, IN HONOR OF HIS MEMORY FOR ALL OF HIS CONTRIBUTIONS AND SERVICES TO THE LAUDERHILL COMMUNITY; PROVIDING THAT THE SECONDARY STREET NAME SHALL BE N.W. 70th AVENUE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY COMMISSIONER RICHARD CAMPBELL)

WHEREAS, Reverend Dr. Melville B. Herron was affectionately known as "Reverend Herron" to so many in the City of Lauderhill; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Herron and his lovely wife Grace moved into the City of Lauderhill in 2001; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Herron was a retired Civil Engineer; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Herron became the President of the Homes of Inverrary Association in January 2002; and

WHEREAS, as President of the Homes of Inverrary Association, Reverend Herron was involved in numerous initiatives in the City of Lauderhill, such as All-America City, promoting two general obligation bonds, and improvements to Jackie Gleason Park; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Herron served on the Citizens on Patrol (COP) team for fourteen (14) years to assist the City of Lauderhill Police Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the renaming of a portion of N.W. 70th Avenue with the Primary Street name to be "Rev. Herron Avenue", in honor of the memory of Reverend Dr. Melville B. Herron for all of his contributions and services to the Lauderhill community; and that the Secondary Street name shall be N.W. 70th Avenue.

Section 2. That the limits of the portion of the road subject to the name change (Rev. Herron Avenue/N.W. 70th Avenue) roadway limits of N.W. 70th Avenue shall begin at the south side of West Commercial Boulevard and extend south approximately 2,025 feet to the that point where Inverrary Boulevard begins and does not extend through Inverrary

Boulevard.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and adoption.
