A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL APPROVING THE RELEASE AND USAGE OF STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS TO ASSIST WITH PURCHASING SEVERAL COMPUTERS FOR USE IN INVESTIGATIONS AND PATROL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$61,500.00; AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FROM THE APPROPRIATE BUDGET CODE NUMBERS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY INTERIM CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, the Guardians Involved for Tomorrow (GIFT) Youth Program is a nonprofit 501c3 organization that assists with the development and guidance of youth in the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill Police Department is requesting to utilize State Law Enforcement Trust Funds to assist with purchasing several computers for use in investigations and patrol and for officer safety equipment to assist with larger crime scenes; and

WHEREAS, the use of these funds is in compliance with state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission hereby authorizes the release and usage of the State Law Enforcement Trust Funds in the amount of \$61,500.00 to assist with purchasing several computers for use in investigations and patrol and for officer safety equipment to assist with larger crime scenes.

SECTION 2. That said payment shall be made from the appropriate budget code number(s).

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
