To date, approximately 400 surtax-funded (MAP Broward) projects have been completed throughout the county. Completed, active, and planned investments within the City of Lauderhill are detailed below.

This document also excludes certain countywide and regional projects, transit services, studies, capital assets (like vehicles), and other surtax investments that cannot be geographically quantified. It includes projects that overlap multiple municipalities and projects recently awarded through the FY 2026 Municipal Surtax Grant Match Program.
