

ORDINANCE NO. 200-06-115

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE II, OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES, DIVISION 3, RETIREMENT, PART 2, GENERAL EMPLOYEES PENSION FUND, SECTION 2-73, DEFERRED RETIREMENT OPTION PLAN; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the City of Lauderhill General Employees Pension Fund has determined that the passage of this ordinance is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Lauderhill; and

WHEREAS, the Plan was recently amended by Ordinance 190-03-102. This ordinance change was based on the collective bargaining agreement entered into with Teamsters Local 769, for the period October 1, 2018, through October September 20, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Plan was recently amended by Ordinance 200-02-109; and

WHEREAS, the Plan should be further amended to revise deferred retirement option plan ("DROP") eligibility based on the October 1, 2018, through September 20, 2021 collective bargaining agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1: Section 2-73 – Deferred retirement option plan.

(a) A deferred retirement option plan ("DROP") is hereby created.

(b) Effective October 1, 2018, eEligibility to participate in the DROP is limited to tier one members and is based upon eligibility for normal service retirement, the date on which the sum of a member's age and years of service with the city equals seventy-five (75). Tier one members who had attained twenty (20) years of service on or before December 31, 2018, are also eligible to participate in the DROP. Prior to October 1, 2018, eligibility was limited to tier one members who had

~~attained twenty (20) years of service regardless of age. Tier two and tier three members are not entitled to participate in the DROP.~~

~~(b) Tier two and tier three members are not entitled to participate in the DROP. Tier one members who have attained twenty (20) years of service on or before December 31, 2018, shall be eligible to participate in the DROP.~~

Section 2: Should this ordinance or any part thereof be declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of any part of this ordinance shall not otherwise affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance, which shall be deemed to have been enacted without the invalid provision.

Section 3: It is the intention of the City Commission of the City of Lauderhill that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of the City of Lauderhill, and that the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5: The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed effective upon adoption.
