

RESOLUTION NO. 21R-04-79

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL CITY COMMISSION IN SUPPORT OF ENDORSING VARIOUS TRANSPORTATION SURTAX (PENNY FOR TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM) WITHIN THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL'S CITY LIMITS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER DESORAE GILES-SMITH)

WHEREAS, Broward County citizens approved by referendum the Transportation Surtax ("Penny for Transportation" Program) on November 6, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Broward County, the Municipalities, and the Broward Metropolitan Organization (MPO) entered the Transportation System Surtax Interlocal Agreement, which provided for a cooperative and organized process for the Municipalities to submit projects for evaluation and funding with Surtax proceeds; and

WHEREAS, a Resolution from the City of Lauderhill's Commission stating support for the project is required to establish funding eligibility with Surtax dollars; and

WHEREAS, officials of The City of Lauderhill feel that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Lauderhill to endorse said projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill commits to administer and deliver the project under the terms of the Second Amendment and Broward County Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, The Culvert Replacement Project for Canal 30 at 82nd Street, will be constructed within the City of Lauderhill's right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, The Bank Stabilization Project for Canal 34, Canal 30 (West), and West Wind Lake, will be constructed within the City of Lauderhill's right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the N.W. 38th Avenue Connector Road Project located along 38th Avenue from N.W. 19th Street and connecting to the Lauderhill Performing Arts Center (3800 N.W. 11th Place), will be constructed within the City of Lauderhill's right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Market Place Gateway Project located at the Northeast corner of West Sunrise Blvd and State Road 7, will be constructed within the City of Lauderhill's right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Bridge Improvement Project for the Bridge located along Inverrary Blvd north of Lime Hill Road, for the Bridge along Inverrary Drive Crossing the C13 Canal, and for the Bridge along Inverrary Blvd crossing the C13 Canal, will be constructed within the City of Lauderhill's right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Drainage and Swale Reconfiguration Program located City Wide, will be constructed within the City of Lauderhill`s right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the 21st Street Resurfacing Program located along 21st Street from State Road 7 to 49th Avenue, will be constructed within the City of Lauderhill`s right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the C13 Pedestrian Bridge Project located parallel to Inverrary Blvd Crossing the C13 Canal, will be constructed within the City of Lauderhill`s right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Curbs, Asphalt, Concrete pads & Sidewalk Construction (ADA Ramps) Program located City Wide, will be constructed within the City of Lauderhill`s right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the N.W. 44th Street Resurfacing Project located along N.W. 44th Street from University Drive to Pine Island Road, will be constructed within the City of Lauderhill`s right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of The City of Lauderhill, to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the projects after their completion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That The City of Lauderhill City Commission hereby supports and endorses The Culvert Replacement Project for Canal 30, The Bank Stabilization Project for Canal 34, The NW 38th Avenue Connector Road Project, The Market Place Gateway Project, The Bridge Improvement Project, The Drainage and Swale Reconfiguration Program, The 21st Street Resurfacing Program, The 21st Street Resurfacing Program, The C13 Pedestrian Bridge Project, The Curbs, Asphalt, Concrete pads & Sidewalk Construction (ADA Ramps) Program, and the NW 44th Street Resurfacing Project and will provide technical assistance when available and needed for the duration of the projects.

SECTION 2. Further, that the City of Lauderhill agrees to maintain, or to coordinate the maintenance, of the projects after their completion.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, her designee, and all appropriate city officials are authorized to execute any documents required to fulfill the terms of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
