We are reaching out on behalf of CPH Inc. CPH has depleted 94% of their funding of \$53780.00 on PO#26700 for this project. The delays in the Construction Contractor's; Inliner Solutions

mobilization has resulted in schedule extension. CPH has expended substantial time and resources beyond the scope initially anticipated. They have requested additional \$27,650.00 to continue assisting the project. Herb Johnson has approved the increase, formal letter attached.

In order for the City to revise the CPH purchase order it has to be approved by Commission, since its over the 10% limit (City's Procurement Policy). **We need your written approval to increase CPH funding from \$53,780 to a total of \$81,430.00 .**

Note: We are not requesting increase in grant funds. CPH request for \$27,650.00 additional funding will be allocated from the original grant amount of \$3,125,215.00.
