

**RESOLUTION NO. 25R-09-184**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL APPROVING THE TENTATIVE BUDGET AS APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026 FOR THE WINDERMERE/TREE GARDENS SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT WHICH SHALL BE INCORPORATED INTO THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026; PROVIDING NOTICE FOR PUBLIC HEARING; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes, Section 163.5151 requires the local governing body of the City where the Safe Neighborhood Improvement District is located to approve the tentative budget of the District prior to the final adoption of the Budget by the Safe Neighborhood Improvement District Board of Directors which will be held on September 29, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The tentative budget for the Windermere/Tree Gardens Safe Neighborhood Improvement District for Fiscal Year 2026 commencing October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2026 in the amount of \$198,730.00, as approved by the Board of Directors, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. It is noted that this tentative budget for the Windermere/ Tree Gardens Safe Neighborhood Improvement District for Fiscal Year 2026 is incorporated as a part of the City of Lauderhill General Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2026.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
