Subject: Use of State Law Enforcement Trust Funds

In 2013, the police department purchased new Glock 22 firearms, utilizing State Law Enforcement Trust Funds, to replace earlier model Glock firearms that were beginning to have routine failures. Over the last eleven years, significant advances have been made in firearms sighting systems, making it better for officers to ensure they are on target, reducing liabilities. Additionally, there has been a movement, in local law enforcement, away from the .40 caliber round currently used by our department and going to a .9mm round. Finally, our weapons are more than ten years old and some are beginning to have mechanical failures.

The Police Department is requesting to utilize State Law Enforcement Trust Funds to purchase new firearms and the ancillary equipment needed to outfit our officers. Additionally, utilizing these funds, we are requesting to purchase the .9mm ammunition that is needed for the training and transition. The requested funds are not to exceed \$210,000. Funding for this purchase can be found in the State Law Enforcement Trust Fund, budget account 120.

Resolution approving the expenditure of \$13,944.00 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF) account # 120-683-9935 to assist with the purchase of 128 new model 22, Generation IV, Glock .40 pistols for use by members of the Police Department from a vendor known as GT Distributors Inc., P.O. Box 458, Rosville, GA. 30741.

Need:

Most of the fire arms being used by members of the police department have been in use for over eighteen years and need to be replaced, thus minimizing the chances of equipment failure during critical incidents.

Summary Explanation/ Background:

The Department requests to purchase 128 new model 22, Generation IV, Glock .40 pistols at a cost of \$409.00 each, totaling \$52,352.00. The vendor will accept 112 of our existing model 22 Glock .40 pistols at a trade-in value of \$334.00 each, totaling \$37,408.00, and 2 of our existing Remington model 700 rifles at a cost of \$500.00 each, totaling \$1,000.00. The total trade-in value of our old weapons is \$38,408.00, thus requiring a budgetary outlay of \$13,944.00.
