METHODOLOGY

- Target five key cities for improving health outcomes, begin by analyzing comprehensive data on health disparities, socioeconomic factors, and existing healthcare infrastructure in various urban areas.
- Identify municipalities with significant disparities and a high prevalence of health issues among underserved populations.
- Collaboration with local stakeholders (Community Base Organizations).
- Develop tailored strategies for each municipalities and promote equitable access to healthcare services.
- Regularly evaluate and adapt interventions based on feedback and evolving needs to ensure sustained improvements in health outcomes.
