### **ORDINANCE NO. 240-09-147**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL CODE OF ORDINANCES, APPENDIX G, FRANCHISES, ARTICLE III, GARBAGE, REFUSE AND TRASH, EXHIBIT "A" AMENDING THE RATE SCHEDULE OF FEES TO GO INTO EFFECT BY THE SERVICE PROVIDER ON OCTOBER 1, 2024; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, DESORAE GILES-SMITH)

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City of Lauderhill Code of Ordinances Appendix G, Franchises, Article III, Garbage, Refuse and Trash, Rate Schedule is hereby amended to be effective commencing October 1, 2024 to read as follows:

# ARTICLE III. GARBAGE, REFUSE AND TRASH<sup>1</sup>

The Franchise Agreement with Waste Management, Inc. of Florida to provide solid waste collection services is hereby approved commencing October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2024 pursuant to the exercise of s five-year option to extend. 2025 pursuant to the Second Revised Amendment to the Agreement as approved via Resolution No. 24R-09-215.

#### **EXHIBIT "A"**

### RATE SCHEDULE—INCLUSIVE OF FRANCHISE FEE

For services required to be performed under this Contract, the charges shall be as follows:

### **FRANCHISE FEE**

The CONTRACTOR shall pay to the CITY of Lauderhill as and for a franchise fee, the amount equal to twenty-two percent (22%) or the dollar amount reflected in the Franchise Fee table below, whichever is greater, if the City elects to provide billing. If the CONTRACTOR does the billing for services rendered, pursuant to this Agreement, within the CITY of Lauderhill the rate of twenty percent (20%) or the dollar amount reflected in the Franchise Fee table below, whichever is greater.
