**Summary Explanation/ Background:**

THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL SOUGHT OUT QUALIFIED BIDDERS TO IMPROVE NW 47TH AVENUE STREET BETWEEN NW 11TH STREET AND NW 26TH STREET IN LAUDERHILL. THE INTENT OF THIS PROJECT IS TO REPAIR BROKEN SIDEWALKS, FULL ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION, MISCELLANEOUS UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS, RESURFACING, CULVERT REPLACEMENT, & ETC. THE CITY RECEIVED PROPOSALS FROM THREE (3) FIRMS INTERESTED IN THE PROJECT. QUALIFIED FIRMS WERE RANKED AND RECOMMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) ENCO, LLC
- 2) FLORIDA ENGINEERING AND DEVELOPMENT CORP.
- 3) CONTINENTAL CONSTRUCTION USA, LLC

IN THE EVENT THE TOP RANKED FIRM IS UNABLE TO MEET THE NEEDS OF THE CITY OR THE CITY MANAGER IS UNABLE TO NEGOTIATE A CONTRACT, STAFF WILL CONTINUE TO THE NEXT FIRM UNTIL THE RANKED LIST HAS BEEN EXHAUSTED.
