A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL 2026 FEDERAL LEGISLATIVE AGENDA TO ESTABLISH THE CITY’S OFFICIAL FEDERAL ADVOCACY PRIORITIES; AUTHORIZING CITY ADMINISTRATION TO ADVOCATE FOR AND TRANSMIT SAID AGENDA TO FEDERAL OFFICIALS AND AGENCIES; PROVIDING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY WITH THE AUTHORITY TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Commission hereby approves and adopts the City of Lauderhill 2026 Federal Legislative Agenda, which establishes the city’s official Federal advocacy priorities.

SECTION 2. That City staff is authorized to advocate for and transmit said Agenda to federal officials and agencies for review and implementation.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this resolution.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
