A RESOLUTION IS REQUIRED FROM THE CITY COMMISSION TO APPROVE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019 HOME REHABILITATION PROGRAM FOR THE DISBURSEMENT OF HOME REHABILITATION FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$108,042 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018/2019.

Need:

ACTION IS REQUIRED TO OBTAIN COMMISSION APPROVAL PRIOR TO ENTERING INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT TO SATISFY BROWARD COUNTY REQUIREMENT FOR CONSORTIA MEMBERS RECEIVING HOME FUNDING.

Summary Explanation/ Background:

THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL'S FY 2018-2019 REHABILITATION PROGRAM HOME AGREEMENT OUTLINES THE PROGRAM THAT WILL PURSUE TO BENEFIT VERY-LOW AND LOW INCOME RESIDENTS WITH ELIGIBLE REHABILITATION SERVICES TO THEIR HOMES. THE GOAL IS TO PROVIDE SERVICES OF UP TO \$20,000 TO QUALIFIED HOMEBUYERS BASED ON THE AREA MEDIAN INCOME FOR FORT LAUDERDALE/BROWARD COUNTY BASED ON THE INCOME LIMITS ESTABLISHED BY HUD, ON AN ANNUAL BASIS. THE PROGRAM IS CRITICAL TO THE SUCCESS OF THE COMMUNITY AS IT PROVIDES A MECHANISM TO SUSTAINABLE HOUSING WHILE REMOVING HEALTH AND SAFETY HAZARDS. STAFF WILL USE THE ATTACHED HOME HOUSING ASSISTANCE PLAN TO IMPLEMENT THIS AGREEMENT.
