AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, PART 1, CHARTER, ARTICLE VIII, CITY CLERK, CITY ATTORNEY, BONDING, SECTION 8.03, CITY ATTORNEY, AS APPROVED BY A MAJORITY VOTE AT THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, CHARLES FARANDA)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City of Lauderhill Code of Ordinances, Part 1, Charter, Article VIII, City Clerk, City Attorney, Bonding, Section 8.03, City Attorney, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 8.03. - City attorney.

The city attorney shall be employed by the commission, be the legal officer of the city, serve as legal advisor to the commission and the city manager, shall assure that the city is represented in all legal proceedings and perform any other duties prescribed by this Charter and by ordinance and shall administer oaths. In the absence of the city attorney, the assistant city attorney shall have all such responsibilities and shall perform all such duties.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed as to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
