

RESOLUTION NO. 21R-03-58

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL APPROVING THE EMERGENCY EXPENDITURE OF FEDERAL FORFEITURE FUNDS IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$51,000.00; APPROVING THE PIGGYBACK OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA CONTRACT WITH INSIGHT PUBLIC SECTOR SLED FOR THE PURCHASE OF 40 LAPTOPS FOR USE BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT FROM BUDGET CODE NUMBER 110-683-09936; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER, DESORAE GILES-SMITH)

WHEREAS, Section 2-144 of the Code provides that the City of Lauderhill may join in on cooperative purchasing plans without bids when the best interests of the City would be served; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida previously solicited bids and awarded a contract to Insight Public Sector Sled; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence for this purchase so cooperative purchasing is necessary and in the best interest of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The waiver of competitive bidding is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The City Commission hereby approves the purchase from Insight Public Sector Sled based upon the piggyback of the State of Florida contract for 40 laptop computers. A copy of the proposal of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. Providing that payment in an amount not to exceed \$51,000.00 from Federal Forfeiture Funds Budget Code Number 110-683-09936 based upon the emergency purchase as set forth in the attached memorandum which is incorporated herein, and which is deemed an appropriate expenditure in accordance with law, is hereby approved.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
