THE WORK INCLUDES BUT NOT LIMITED TO MOBILIZATION, CLEARING & GRUBBING, TRAFFIC CONTROL, ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION, PAVEMENT WIDEDING, MILLING & RESURFACING, CURB & GUTTER INSTALLATION, SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION, CROSSWALKS, LANDSCAPING, IRRIGATION AND SIGNING & PAVEMENT MARKING INSTALLATION IN ORDER TO CONSTRUCT TWO (2) ROUNABOUTS, AS WELL AS FIVE (5) CORRESPONDING SPEED HUMPS.
