A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) STATE HIGHWAY LIGHTING, MAINTENANCE, AND COMPENSATION AGREEMENT FOR MAINTAINING FDOT FACILITIES WITHIN THE CITY; AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SEVEN YEAR AGREEMENT, NEGOTIATE THE COMPENSATION AND TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY EFFECTUATE THE TERMS OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY INTERIM CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has updated its Highway Lighting, Maintenance and Compensation Agreements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill has entered into agreements with FDOT to maintain its facilities located in the City and wishes to continue to do so; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it is in the best interests of the City to authorize the Interim City Manager to enter into the seven-year Agreement with FDOT to maintain its facilities located in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Interim city manager is further authorized to negotiate with FDOT the compensation to be paid to the City as discussed in Exhibit A to the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The above recitations are true and correct.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The Interim City Manager is authorized to enter into the seven-year Agreement with FDOT to maintain its facilities located in the City, at a cost to be negotiated between the parties, said agreement is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, and to do all things necessary to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
