Subject: Use of State Seizure Law Enforcement Trust Funds

This memorandum is authored to serve as a request to utilize State Law Enforcement Trust Funds, to purchase a KeyTrak key and inventory electronic management system and an Elastec Drug Terminator portable incinerator. These items are non-budgeted items that have become necessary for providing efficient services in the police department. The account number in which these funds can be found is 120-683-9935, with a balance of \$135,467.20 as of June 9, 2021.

The police department is a twenty-four hour, seven days a week operation. During our history, our fleet and equipment inventory has more than doubled. It has become more of a challenge to monitor and manage our inventory and make needed items available, afterhours and on weekends. The KeyTrak inventory control system will allow the department to electronically manage access to car keys, Narcotics test kits and other equipment that at times has resulted in a call out of staff to issue this equipment. The cost of the KeyTrak computerized system is \$16,446.59.

Purging of narcotics and disposable evidence is a mandate of Florida State Statute and our Accreditation. There is a legal process that we follow and upon approval from the courts, we contract with an outside vendor to incinerate these items. This requires two sworn officers and two civilian employees to package and transport the narcotics to the location for disposal. The purchase of Elastec Drug Terminator portable incinerator would streamline this process allowing us to dispose of these items on site. This would significantly reduce staff time to complete this process. The Elastec Drug Terminator \$4,240.00.

As such, I am requesting the use of funds not to exceed \$22,000 in State Law Enforcement Trust Funds to purchase these items. This funding will provide the police department the ability to better manage inventory as save on staff time.

Subject: Property and Evidence/Narcotics Destruction

In an effort to reduce cost and increase efficiency within the Property and Evidence Division the attached equipment (Elastec Incinerator) would be extremely beneficial to the agency.

Currently the department utilizes Wheelabrator for the purge/destruction of narcotics at a cost of approximately \$500.00 dollars per burn/destruction. Along with the associated cost also comes a difficulty in scheduling the available days with Wheelabrator to destroy/purge the evidence. In speaking with the manufacturer of Elastic's Portable Incinerator, the benefits include, portability, minimal amount of space to operate and its very simple to operate. I have done some research and it appears that there are numerous agencies within the State of Florida that are currently utilizing this equipment. Some local agencies currently utilizing the equipment are Coral Springs PD, Margate PD, Sunrise PD, Fort Lauderdale PD and Miami Dade PD, all of which maintain accredited status through the CFA.

On the Police Departments property is the former bicycle storage area that we would be able to utilize for the incineration of narcotic related evidence. The former bicycle storage area would be a perfect location being that the area is enclosed. Utilizing this area would provide safety for the operator of the equipment and could be a dedicated area for this process once cleaned up.

Drug Terminator Frequently Asked Questions

Can I use this where I am located?

The Drug Terminator falls into the category of Cyclonic Barrel Burner covered by EPA Regulation 40 CFR Part 60 (Standards of Performance) exempted under section 60.2555. Always contact your regulatory authority before use.

What can I burn in the unit?

Narcotics, pharmaceuticals, paraphernalia, clothing, most evidence, documents, etc.

How much does it burn?

The Drug Terminator is rated at 50lbs/hr but has been known to burn up to 300lbs/hr depending on the type of material being destroyed.

Is there any smoke?

The Drug Terminator releases some smoke when first started but this is only wood or charcoal smoke and therefore harmless. Once it reaches temperature, there should be no smoke or smell released by the unit to affect the operators or bystanders.

Is any PPE required?

Heat resistant gloves and safety glasses are recommended but nothing further should be required.


