

RESOLUTION NO. 25R-11-223

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS TO AUTHORIZE AN AGREEMENT WITH FERGUSON US HOLDINGS, INC. D/B/A FERGUSON ENTERPRISES, LLC, BASED ON A PIGGYBACK OF THE CITY OF DEERFIELD BEACH INVITATION TO BID NUMBER 25-017 TO PROVIDE WATER METER FITTINGS, WATER LINE AND FIRE HYDRANT ACCESSORIES; AUTHORIZING PAYMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$90,000; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO ENTER INTO THE APPROPRIATE PIGGYBACK AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY INTERIM CITY MANAGER KENNIE HOBBS, JR.).

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-144 of the City's Code, the City of Lauderhill ("City") may waive its on competitive bidding and join in on cooperative purchasing plans when in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, Deerfield Beach, Florida, issued an Invitation to Bid Number 25-017 to provide water meter fittings, water line and fire hydrant accessories, and entered an agreement with Ferguson US Holdings, DBA Ferguson Enterprises, LLC ("Ferguson Enterprises"); and

WHEREAS, the City, pursuant to section 2-144 of the City's Code, wishes to piggyback from Deerfield Beach solicitation and enter into an agreement with Ferguson Enterprises for the replacement of four 30 inch butterfly valves for the ongoing repairs to the Lauderhill water treatment plant in an amount not to exceed \$90,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The above recitations are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The City is authorized to enter into an agreement with Ferguson Enterprises, under the Deerfield Beach solicitation in an amount not to exceed \$90,000, for the replacement of four 30-inch butterfly valves for the ongoing repairs to the Lauderhill water treatment plant, to be made from the appropriate budget code numbers.

SECTION 3. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to enter into the appropriate piggyback agreement.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
