A RESOLUTION IS REQUESTED FROM THE CITY COMMISSION TO APPROVE THE RECOMMENDED RANKING OF THE EVALUATION COMMITTEE FOR RFP 2021-013 DISASTER DEBRIS MONITORING TO DEBRISTECH.

Need:

ACTION IS NEEDED FOR SELECTED FIRM TO PROVIDE DISASTER DEBRIS MONITORING THROUGHOUT THE CITY DURING DISASTER SITUATIONS PER FEMA GUIDELINES.

Summary Explanation/ Background:

DEBRISTECH WILL PROVIDE DISASTER RECOVERY GUIDANCE TO STAFF BY USING AN IN HOUSE DEVELOPED ELECTRONIC DEBRIS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM. THIS SYSTEM WILL ALLEVIATE THE BURDEN OF MONITORING THE PROCESS OF THE DEBRIS REMOVAL SO THAT ALL COSTS INCURRED ARE ELIGIBLE FOR REIMBURSEMENT BY FEMA. DEBRIS REMOVAL MONITORING IS A VERY ENGAGED PROCESS REQUIRING FOCUS AND UNDERSTANDING OF MANY AREAS OF OPERATION AND FEDERAL GUIDELINES.
