## **Peggy Nisbett-Rigg**

Peggy Nisbett-Rigg has been involved in planning and organizing community events and affairs since her arrival in Florida with her parents in 1979. Her father founded the first West Indian Community Club – a social organization for all Caribbean nations living in Miami Dade, Broward and Palm Beach Counties. She played an active role in that organization and has continued her community involvement as a Board of Director and Chair for Unifest (Broward County’s oldest Multicultural Caribbean Cultural Festival). She also serves on the Board of Directors for the Greater Caribbean Chamber of Commerce and the Lauderdale Lakes Chamber of Commerce.

Mrs. Rigg has assisted with political campaigns, organized fundraisers, parking event coordinator and has been a facilitator with the American Cancer Society. She has established very important business and political relationships with Consul Generals of Jamaica, Bahamas, Trinidad & Tobago, Grenada, Guyana, Barbados, St. Lucia, former State Senator Chris Smith, Mayor Dale Holness, Mayors Hazelle Rogers and Kenneth Thurston, Lauderdale Lakes Commissioners, Miramar Commissioners, North Lauderdale Commissioners, Lauderhill Commissioners, Local Sheriffs, City Police officers, City Managers, local libraries and Park & Recreation managers. She is the recipient of the prestigious Women’s History Month Award which she obtained in March 2019 and two local business community awards.
