A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA, AWARDING THE KEY TO THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL TO JAMAICA WOMEN OF FLORIDA IN RECOGNITION OF THE IMPACT ON WOMEN OF THE JAMAICAN COMMUNITY AND CARIBBEAN DIASPORA IN FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY MAYOR DENISE GRANT).

WHEREAS, the key to the City of Lauderhill is the most prestigious award in the City and is used to recognize exceptional achievement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill is honored to recognize non-profit organizations that positively impact the community and celebrate cultural heritage through their dedication and service; and

WHEREAS, since 2013, the Jamaica Women of Florida (JWOF), a charitable organization has been impacting the women of Jamaican heritage through charitable initiatives, particularly those focused on women's and children's issues in the State of Florida for more than a decade.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the above recitations are true and hereby incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission of the City of Lauderhill hereby awards a Key to the City of Lauderhill to the Jamaican Women of Florida in recognition of the unwavering commitment to charitable initiatives that address the needs of the Jamaican community, particularly women and girls.

SECTION 3. That the City Commission of the City of Lauderhill presents a copy of this Resolution to the Jamaica Women of Florida as a symbol of the City's appreciation for the remarkable contributions advocating for issues affecting Jamaican and the broader Caribbean diaspora community.
