Key Contributions to Date


- Documented key decisions and recommendations

Interim Strategic Plan Adoption – Setting the Stage for 2027

Phase 1 – Quick Wins (Nov 2025 – Jan 2026)

- Adopt Interim Strategic Plan
- Launch 90-Day Quick Wins initiatives
- Deliver high-impact, visible results to build accountability
- Improve performance scores tied to 2022 survey results
- Track and showcase progress with before/after project video series

Phase 2 – Strategic Plan Development (FY 2026–2027)

- Build on lessons learned from Quick Wins to guide long-term priorities
- Establish detailed timeline for citywide strategic actions
- Conduct 2026 business and resident survey to capture updated needs
- Expand engagement with Commission, boards, HOAs, and residents
- Position City for October 2027 adoption of the next Strategic Plan
