

ORDINANCE NO. 210-04-111

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE IV, CITY COMMISSION, SECTION 2-151, REGULAR MEETINGS TO PROVIDE THAT CITY COMMISSION MEETINGS SHALL START AT 6:00 P.M.; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY MAYOR KEN THURSTON)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1: That the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Administration, Article IV, City Commission, Section 2-151, Regular Meetings, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-151. - Regular meetings.

Regular meetings of the city commission shall be held on the second and last Monday of each month, at ~~7:00~~ 6:00 p.m. in the commission chambers within the city or any other location within the city as may be designated by majority vote of the commission members present either physically or via a form of telecommunication. Any regular meeting may be rescheduled or cancelled by a majority vote of the commission. Petitions and communications from the public shall convene at ~~7:00~~ 6:00 p.m. at the beginning of every regular meeting, and shall terminate prior to ~~7:30~~ 6:30 p.m. The remainder of the regular meeting shall commence immediately following the conclusion of petitions and communications from the public or at ~~7:30~~ 6:30 p.m., whichever shall occur first. The chair, or a designee, of each city board and committee is required to make a presentation to update the city commission as to the status of matters being addressed by them during the presentations portion the meeting on a rotating basis as necessary. The scheduling of the various boards or committees to their presentations shall be approved by the city manager.

Section 2: Should this ordinance or any part thereof be declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of any part of this ordinance shall not otherwise affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance, which shall be deemed to have been enacted without the invalid provision.

Section 3: It is the intention of the City Commission of the City of Lauderhill that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of the City of Lauderhill, and that the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5: This provision of this ordinance shall become effective as of the date of passage.
