Pass a Resolution to approve the Tentative Tax Levy for the Habitat Safe Neighborhood Improvement District Fiscal Year 2026 the proposed Millage Rate of 1.0 Mills and proposed Non-ad Valorem Special Assessment in the amount of \$125.00 per parcel of land per year from the District area.

Need Summary Explanation/ Background:

Pass a Resolution to approve the Tentative Tax Levy for the Habitat Safe Neighborhood Improvement District Fiscal Year 2026 the proposed Millage Rate of 1.0 Mills and proposed Non-ad Valorem Special Assessment in the amount of \$125.00 per parcel of land per year from the District area.

Florida Statutes, Section 163.5151 requires the Habitat Safe Neighborhood Improvement District to adopt a Resolution and Ordinance for the Tentative Tax Levy of the Millage Rate for each Fiscal Year. These taxes are included within the District Budget which is incorporated into and becomes a part of the City of Lauderhill General Budget for Fiscal Year 2026. Pursuant to the Statutory requirement, prior to the adoption of the Final Tax Levy by the District Board of Directors on September 29, 2025, the Tentative Tax Levy of the Proposed Millage Rate must be approved by the City Commission of the City of Lauderhill. This Resolution is the approval by the City Commission for the Tentative Tax Levy at the Proposed Millage Rate of 1.0 Mills as approved by the District Board of Directors prior to the adoption of the Final Ordinance by the Safe Neighborhood Improvement District Board of Directors. The proposed non-ad valorem special assessment of \$125.00 per parcel and the ad valorem tax of 1.0 Mills designated within the Budget will be collected utilizing the uniform method of collection on the Annual Tax Bill. Authorization is given to the District to levy ad valorem taxes up to 1.0 mills annually and non ad-valorem special assessments to support planning & implementation of district improvements not to exceed \$125 for each individual parcel of land per year. The preliminary estimated rate of assessment was passed via Resolution No. 25R-07-136 on July 15, 2025.

Cost Summary/ Fiscal Impact:

Anticipate revenues to be collected in the amount of \$39,285.00 from special assessments and \$32,934.00 for tax levy millage for a total anticipated revenue of \$72,219.00
