Thank you to all that attended Monday's meeting. We greatly appreciate your time and effort in making sure we are moving forward on this very important project.

I have attached the PowerPoint presentation from the meeting. The next milestone is for each municipality to designate two elected officials, one to serve as the representative and one as the alternate representative, respectively, as a participating member of the MOU for the municipality. Please note: this is not the MOU working group, it is the group that will decide the composition of the working group, along with other matters as necessary. In addition, each municipality may participate in the Technical Group, which would be primarily staff. If your municipality wishes to have a representative on the Technical Group, please let us know, as well as the person that would serve on behalf of the municipality.

As discussed yesterday, this is a tight timeframe – please be prepared to agenda this matter before your first Commission meeting in November so that we maintain the integrity of our timeline. A draft resolution for your is also attached for those municipalities that would make the appointments by resolution.
